OVERVIEW

Communication is key! The Presidents of tribal networks aim to maintain contact with ministry leaders across remote regions on a consistent basis, coordinating efforts and providing training, counsel, and encouragement. However, cell phone and internet service can be weak and unreliable in areas. Access to better technology can be such a useful tool in ministry! Zoom meetings & messaging capabilities help bridge the distance across remote rainforest areas.


